Curriculum is designed such that lessons are taught with an aim to achieve higher order of thinking.

Discipline

- (a) Punctuality & regularity in attendance, school uniform, earnest efforts in the home work assigned and polite behaviour inside and outside the school premises are necessary for the formation of character and to create a suitable environment for learning. The school authorities will always therefore, insist on these aims. Being highly detrimental to juvenile constitution, pupils are strictly bidden to use them in the Academy campus.
- (b) The Principal reserves to herself the right to dismiss students who fail to make satisfactory progress in their studies or whose conduct is in any way detrimental to the institution. For immorality or insubordination, a student may be dismissed without prior notice to the parents / guardians.
- (c) Students are strictly forbidden to leave the school premises during school hours without the express permission of the Principal.
- (d) To avoid interference with the teaching, parents / guardians must not contact teachers or pupils during class-hours. All business will be transacted in the office.
- (e) If a Pupil were to be withdrawn during the term, full term's school dues must be paid before the transfer certificate could be issued.
- (f) If a pupil fails to pay the fees within the fixed time, he/she will not be allowed to attend the class from the I of the second month and consequently, his/her name will be removed from the rolls in the following month.
- (g) Every student of the school must positively pay all the dues latest by 10th March of the academic year. If a student fails to clear the dues, he/she shall be prevented from attending classes or appearing in any of the examination.
- (h) No concession in fee is made for broken periods.
- (i) Results will not be given to pupils who fail to clear the school dues.
- (j) Students must speak English in the school premises.
- (k) Students should observe cleanliness within the class room as well as outside. They should have a decent hair style that is becoming.

- (I) Students regularly absenting themselves from the classes must explain to the Principal in writing the reason for their absence. It is highly desirable that students submit their application for leave prior to availing it.
- (m) Pupils are required to produce a medical certificate from an M.B.B.S. Doctor if they have absented themselves from the school because of sickness.
- (n) Pupils must rejoin classes after any holiday on the re-opening day. Breach of this rule will be considered a punishable offence. Moreover, any student arriving later than three days from the date of reopening of the school will lose his/her seat.
- (o) No late-comer will be allowed to attend the classes. He/she will be asked immediately to go home at the risk of the parents/guardians.
- (p) Books, periodicals, newspapers, comics, mobiles, electronic gadgets or anything of an objectionable or distracting nature shall not be brought into the school premises. If found, they will be confiscated and handed over to parents.
- (q) Any damage done to the school building or furniture shall be made good by the pupils concerned. The decision of the Principal regarding the compensation to be paid shall be final.
- (r) Pupils are responsible for the safe custody of their cycles, books, umbrellas, rain coats, tiffin boxes, water bottles etc.
- (s) Any child caught handling or taking away the belongings of others shall be immediately expelled from the school.
- (t) Consuming Alcohol, Chewing Gum, Masala and Smoking are strictly forbidden.
- (u) Once a student comes to school, he/she will not be allowed to go home. No visitors will be allowed to meet any student, specially girls in the school.
- (v) In emergency cases, the child will be sent home only with parents. In no case the child will be sent on his own request or the request of the parents through him/her.
- (w) Parents are not allowed to go straight to the class room to see their wards or the teachers. Parents can meet the teacher to know about the work and progress of their wards only on the meeting day or just after school.

- (x) The parents are requested to find out from the assignment book whether the child takes down the home work every day and completes the work regularly.
- (y) This little co-operation of parents in this direction will save many botheration at the end of the year.
- (z) The student must have all the books, note books as early as possible after the new session starts and the parents must see that the children specially in lower classes come to school with books and exercise books as per schedule of the day.

Transportation

Student's must keep their conveyance i.e. bicycles in the stand at their own risk. The school will not compensate if the same is missing. The students are allowed to come to school by bicycles and not by motorbikes and cars on their own selves.

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If you choose the bus service, the entire annual fee will apply. However, for June, only 70% of the fee will be charged.
